

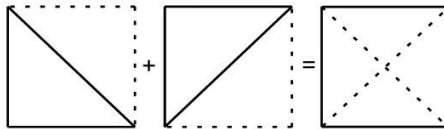

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FOLDED PAPER GAME

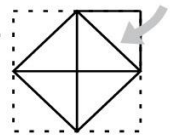
1. Begin with the square piece of paper. The blank side should be facing you when folding with writing on the other side.



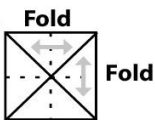
2. To determine the centre point, fold paper in half twice, folding point to point, then open out flat.



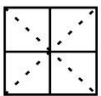
3. Fold each corner into the centre.



5. Fold the resulting square along the lines shown, then open out again.



6. Turn the square over. It should look like this.

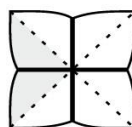


7. Lift flaps in each corner, and insert finger and thumb of each hand into them.



8. The appearance of the paper will now be something like this.

9. Using fingers and thumbs, bring all four points together.



10. They can then be moved in pairs, either vertically or horizontally to reveal flaps underneath by opening and closing fingers and thumbs.
