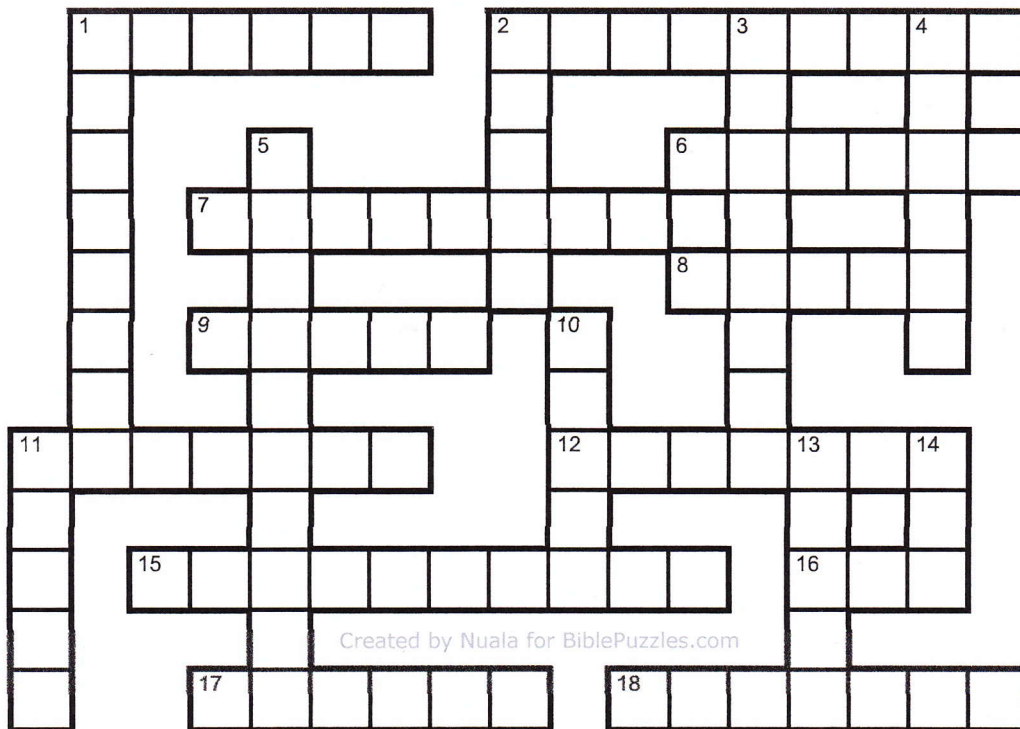


# Paul's Missionary Journeys
